Participation in the **ROMA RIGHTS BIKE** involves the obligation for all participants to comply with this regulation, in its entirety.

ART.1 – RACE CYCLING COMPETITIVE AND NOT COMPETITIVE STARTING PLACE

Competitive Cycling Races (15km) and Non Competitive (10km) **ROME RIGHTS BIKE** will take place with Departure at the **MONUMENT TERME DI CARACALLA** Viale delle Terme di Caracalla - 00153 Rome (RM).

Competitive Cycling (15km) and Not Competitive (10km) Competitions will be held on the days of:

- Saturday, July 13th:
 - at 08.00 (Departure Competitive Cycling)
 - at 10.00 (Departure Not Competitive)

ART.3 - MARATHON FORMULA AND HALF MARATHON

The Competitive and Not Competitive cycling competition will be divided into men and women, age and there will be staggered start times. There will be bib numbers and race numbers of different colors for the two competitions. You can participate in only one competition and only one age group.

ART.4 - RULES

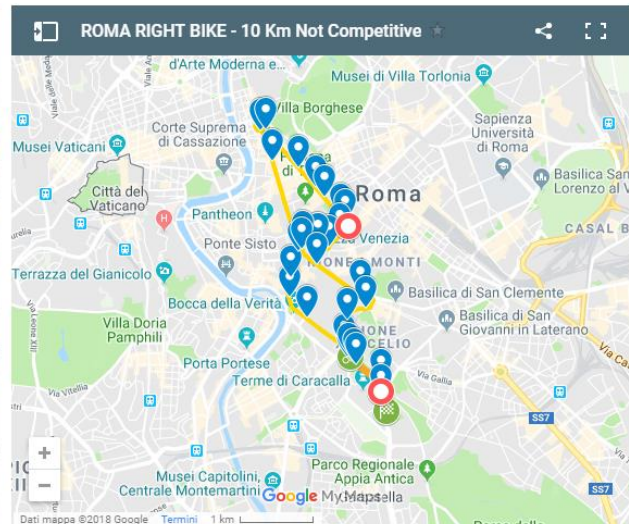
The rules established by UCI (International Union Cycling) <https://www.uci.org/> will be applied.

CYCLE COMPETITION ROUTE 15 km COMPETITIVE

Start Viale delle Terme di Caracalla, height stop ATAC, with crossing of the main historical monuments of the city along: Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [central lane], Piazza di Porta Capena, Via dei Cerchi (km 1), Via Petroselli [hand lane], Via del Teatro di Marcello [hand lane], Piazza Venezia [1st passage, opposite side], Via del Corso (km 2 and km 3), Piazza del Popolo [around inside the square following the perimeter walls], Via del Babuino [in contrast] (km 4), Piazza di Spagna [compared to Barcaccia, Via Condotti side passage], Via dei Due Macelli (5 km), Via del Traforo, Umberto I tunnel, Via Milano, Via Nazionale, Piazza Magnanapoli, Via Quattro Novembre (6 km), Via Cesare Battisti, Piazza Venezia [2nd passage, opposite side], Via dei Fori Imperiali (km 7), Piazza del Colosseo [hand lane], Via Celio Vibenna [hand lane], Via di San Gregorio [hand lane] (km 8), Piazza di Porta Capena [back on carriageway central and, on the other hand], Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [central roadway, contra-lane, outbound] (km 9), turn of boa on the central roadway and back on the side lane Stadium, turn of boa [from the central road to the side of the stadium, height end of the roadway], Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [side roadway side on the stadium] (km 10), Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [side lane, uphill towards Mura Ardeatine], Via Guido Baccelli [by hand, gone] (km 11), Largo Fioritto [anticlockwise turn of the roundabout], Via Guido Baccelli [by hand, return], Largo Terme di Caracalla [passage under the right hand archway] (km 12), Viale di Porta Ardeatina, Passage under the arches, Via Guerrieri (13 km), Viale Giotto, Piazzale Ostiense, Via della Piramide Cestia, Piazza Albania (14 km), Viale Aventino, Piazza di Porta Capena, Largo Vittime del Terrorismo and **Stop** Nando Martellini Stadium - 15 km.

CYCLE ROUTE 10 km NON COMPETITIVE

Start Viale delle Terme di Caracalla, height stop ATAC, with crossing of the main historical monuments of the city along: Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [central lane], Piazza di Porta Capena, Via dei Cerchi (km 1), Via Petroselli [hand lane], Via del Teatro di Marcello [hand lane], Piazza Venezia [1st passage, opposite side], Via del Corso (km 2 and km 3), Piazza del Popolo [around inside the square following the perimeter walls] , Via del Babuino [in contrast] (km 4), Piazza di Spagna [compared to Barcaccia, Via Condotti side passage], Via dei Due Macelli (5 km), Via del Traforo, Umberto I tunnel, Via Milano, Via Nazionale, Piazza Magnanapoli, Via Quattro Novembre (6 km), Via Cesare Battisti, Piazza Venezia [2nd passage, opposite side], Via dei Fori Imperiali (km 7), Piazza del Colosseo [hand lane], Via Celio Vibenna [hand lane], Via di San Gregorio [hand lane] (km 8), Piazza di Porta Capena [back on carriageway central and, on the other hand], Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [central roadway, contra-lane, outbound] (km 9), turn of boa on the central roadway and back on the side lane Stadium, turn of boa [from the central road to the side of the stadium, height end of the roadway], and **Stop** Viale delle Terme di Caracalla [lateral side roadway] (km 10).

ART.7 - DATES AND PARTICIPATION FEES

Registration to the EuroGames Rome 2019 will officially start on 26.09.2018.

1. Until the 31.12.2018 only European athletes can be registered.
2. From 01.01.2019 registrations will be open to the rest of the world.

Registrations will close on 31.05.2019. Registration in the various sports may close even before the official closing date, if the maximum number of participants is reached.

A single fee is charged: € 50.00

The Athlete participation fee includes:

1. Participation in the sport
2. Free access to sports facilities
3. Insurance Card against accidents and damage to third parties
4. Participation in the inauguration and closing ceremony
5. Participation 2 cultural events: a conference and a workshop *
6. Participation kit, gadget and complete program
7. Access to the EuroGames Sport Village
8. Discount coupons for restaurants in the EuroGames Sport Village
9. Discount coupons for the main LGBTI evenings and entertainment in Rome

* to participate, however, send an email to support@romaeurogames2019.org indicating in the object the words: **CULTURE - EVENT NAME - REGISTRATION CODE** (code that is sent in the email confirming the registration)

ART.8 - INSURANCE CANCELLATION PARTICIPATION

The EuroGames Rome 2019 Organization has negotiated for its participants an insurance option that covers registration fees. For a single payment of € 5.50 (per registration and per person, regardless of the amount of participation fees), each participant can be reimbursed:

1. Delivery fees (up to 40%), in case of accident or serious illness, physical inability to participate, death in the family, in case of dismissal and also due to a change of leave by the employer.

2. Of registration fees (up to 80%), in case of cancellation of the event by the Organization (adverse meteorological events, insufficient number of participants ...), for which one registered.

This voluntary insurance shall be paid at the time of registration. After the registration the participant Portal subscription will receive from the organization with the application form which must be completed in its entirety, signed and returned to the organization that confirms successful subscription and the Request Refund Form. You can deliver the application form until two days before the closing date (up to 28.05.2019).

ART.9 - ACCREDITATION

Each participant must register with the accreditation office presenting:

- A valid identity document
- Paper or digital copy (by mobile phone) of the registration confirmation email

No player will be allowed to participate without appropriate identification.

The Accreditation office will be located at the EuroGames Sport Village where it will be issued to each participant:

- The accreditation badge for access to the sports areas and to the EuroGames Sport Village
- The welcome package with gadgets, event program, transport and emergency numbers, Rome guides and much more.

The Accreditation office will be operational from Friday 5 July 2019 to Saturday 13 July 2019 from 10.00 to 22.00. On Thursday, July 11th, the Accreditation office will close at 4pm due to the Opening Ceremony.

ART.10 - SPORTS FITNESS CERTIFICATE AND IDENTITY DOCUMENT

The participants:

- They must be in possession of the Sport Fitness Certificate with the specification of the sport practiced that must be attached during the registration procedure following the instructions contained in the page <http://www.romaeurogames2019.org/athlete/>

• They must be in possession of the Identity Document that must be attached during the registration procedure by following the instructions contained in the page <http://www.romaeurogames2019.org/athlete/>

ART.10 - ACCIDENT INSURANCE AND CIVIL LIABILITY TO THIRD PARTIES

ART.11 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

All participants must have a correct and sporty behavior. Each participant in the registration procedure must accept the following rules in order to participate:

- **Standards on EuroGames**

Any behavior not considered suitable by the Tournament Organization will result in exclusion from the tournament and removal from the Sports Facilities.

ART.12 - PUBLICATION RESULT

The results of each single day will be published on the website and communicated by the Organization via email to all participants. The results will also be visible in the Sports Center on a board prepared by the Organization. The final results will highlight the first, second and third classified of each event for each age group with indication of the Name, Surname, City, Country.

ART.13 - AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

Or each event Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to each member of the winning team. Specific awards will be foreseen according to the roles within the team.

ART.14 - WHERE TO DO DURING
